

New road to Kericho opened



REALIGNMENT CUTS SEVEN MILES OFF FORMER ROUTE

THE new road to Kericho via Kendoa is now open to the public, the Ministry of Works announced yesterday. It is 22 miles long—saving seven miles on the old route via Lumwa—and has fewer corners and easier gradients.

Work began on the new road in 1957 and has involved major engineering works and a number of bridges. At present the road has been constructed up to gravel standard but this route is included in the Road Authority's bituminisation programme under the £4,000,000 contractor-finance scheme.

The Road Authority also plans to realign and reconstruct the road between Kendoa and Mau Summit, and work has already started on surveying a better alignment between Kericho and Abern, in Central Nyanza. These improvements should considerably shorten the time required to travel from Mau Summit to Kisumu.

While the Minister of Works is a warm supporter of the major road construction work now in progress between Kericho and Nyeri may cause temporary interruptions and disturbance to traffic during the coming rainy season.

The passage of lorries and buses over the route may have to be suspended temporarily after heavy rain.
