LINKS WITH KENYA OVER 50 YEARS

THE distance between Sweden and Kenya is considerable in mileage. Kenya being cut by the Equator and Sweden by the Arctic Circle. Yet the two countries are far apart by distance and climate but very close in many respects. Sweden has a population of 2,500,000 in an area of 473,000 square miles, compared with Kenya's 4,000,000 in an area of 225,000 square miles. The first Swedish visitor to Kenya was 50 years ago and since that time there has been a continuous flow of trade, investment, and technical cooperation between the two countries. Today about 100 Swedish firms are doing business in Kenya.

The Swedes, through the Svenska Handelstjänst, have a large number of agents in Kenya, and about 25,000 Swedish firms have established a firm in Kenya. Among other things, these firms have established high-grade steel plants, particularly in Mombasa, and many other industrial plants, including a large steel rolling mill. The Swedes also have a large number of technical and engineering firms in Kenya, and many of these firms have established a firm in Kenya.

Kenya's exports to Sweden amount to about \$10,000,000 and consist mainly of coffee, tea, and other agricultural products. 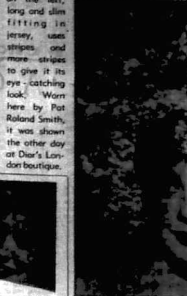

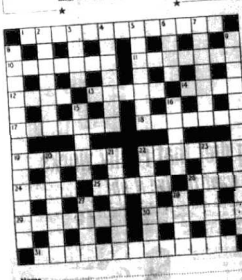
