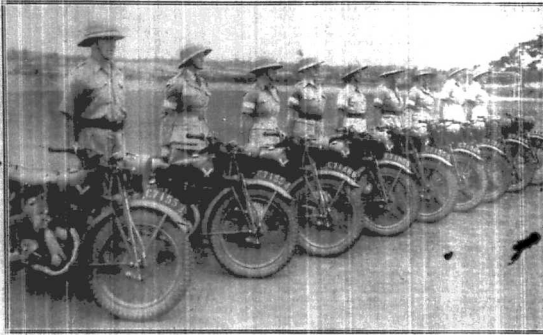

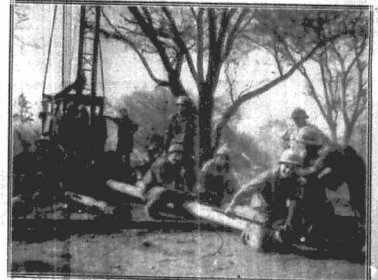

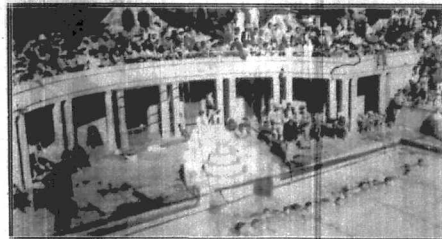

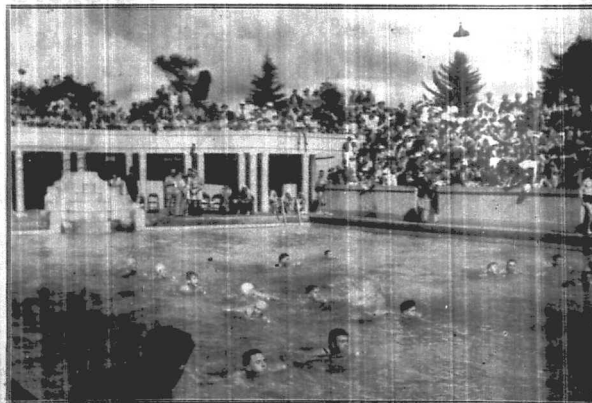

WEAVING THE FUTURE IN UKAMBA

ON the Northern slope of the Matungu hills, where they look across the plains to the great ranges of the Aberdeens, the hamlets of Dorjo Sudak, the serrated peaks of the Ng'wo hills and the towers of Kenya itself (so wide is the prospect), there lies the small Government station of Kamugo.

It is small in size but great in its importance. For it is the centre of an arable and prosperous rural community, not only in sound management but also in the practice of the crafts of the village, spinning and weaving, brick-making, its work, looked and run with regularity and spirit. It could be established at Kamugo a school of village crafts. The first step in the way to this end was to set up on every day to find whether the school will be really self-sufficient.

CONTROL OF ENGLISH POTATOES

The Supply Board has decided to introduce control of the potato crop in order to obtain military requirements, to ensure the equitable distribution of the produce and to prevent inflation.

The necessary Order to give effect to this is published under the Government Notice in the London Gazette of 12th May, 1940.

Under this Order, an producer of potatoes, who is permitted to produce on behalf of a producer or after November 1, 1940, will be required to supply to the Supply Board at such centres as the Board may designate, a certain quantity of potatoes. The Board is, however, empowered to exempt any producer whose deliveries are considered essential for the normal needs of the country, or to arrange for applications of those producers to supply to other centres as set out in the purchasing agent's list.

Potatoes fit for consumption through the Supply Board are of the grades named in the Schedule to the Order, and are to be supplied to the Supply Board at such centres as the Board may designate, a certain quantity of potatoes. The Board is, however, empowered to exempt any producer whose deliveries are considered essential for the normal needs of the country, or to arrange for applications of those producers to supply to other centres as set out in the purchasing agent's list.

The Control will not sell to traders or other persons in less than ten ton lots or to persons who are not normally professional dealers or purchasers in these quantities. Any person requiring potatoes in less than ten ton lots will be required to purchase through the Supply Board at such centres as the Board may designate, a certain quantity of potatoes. The Board is, however, empowered to exempt any producer whose deliveries are considered essential for the normal needs of the country, or to arrange for applications of those producers to supply to other centres as set out in the purchasing agent's list.

When the people of the East African continent will look to every Government in East, West and South Africa. It is a great public task to provide a nucleus of the large amount that will be necessary to assist in the relief of our troops. But in the meantime we hope that East Africa will respond generously to the final appeal for much more aid from the British people, whose sufferings are immeasurably greater than they are in any other part of the world in the future will face a force operating in Africa, or the civilian population.

NAIROBI CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Big Agenda Necessitates An Extra Meeting

On Friday evening the Nairobi Chamber of Commerce under the chairmanship of the President, Mr. A. A. Lawrence, held a long and comprehensive agenda until a late hour. It was in fact deemed necessary to hold over a number of items which would be dealt with at a special meeting to be held on Thursday next, November 21.

There was a big debate on the mercantile concerning public holidays in which it was urged that before they should be considered, the commercial community should first discuss the advisability of the proposed War Risks Insurance Bill which was also brought up.

In connection with the delegates report it was decided that, in view of the ground covered at the annual meeting, the Chamber should not vote on the points concerned at this particular meeting.

Resolutions passed at the season were also dealt with and the President, Mr. A. A. Lawrence, reported to the Chamber on the proceedings of the session of the Associated Chambers.

Regarding delays in the receipt of shipping documents, further information on the subject will be sought. The requisitioning of offices by the military authorities was another item dealt with at the meeting. It was stated that it was understood that the military authorities were making a survey of their requirements.

In view of that fact and that the Financial Secretary as Chairman of the Supply Board must sign all requisitions for supplies required by the military as offices, it was decided not to take any action at the present meeting.

Man Power Register

Man Power was another item discussed. The need for a register of man power was stressed and it was stated that there did not appear to be any such register of the Nairobi area, which was considered to be necessary for the proper allocation of duties for A.R.P. purposes. Special Police and R.C.P. services. It was decided to ask Government to investigate the compilation of such a register in order that all requisites services could be met in an efficient manner.

Another matter discussed was the disposal of unclaimed balances in the hands of the Official Receiver.

BOXER BOMBED

Johnny Peters Hurt In Air Raid

[STANDARD CORRESPONDENT] London.

Johnny Peters, the well-known boxer, is in hospital in a precarious condition, suffering from multiple injuries received when a large bomb fell in South London.
