

GOOD ADVICE FOR BEGINNERS IN FLORAL EXHIBITS

MANY horticultural societies boast the lists of members of younger people who are exhibitors are entries of their own, and there is plenty of enthusiasm; only much experience will tell you what to do. To exhibit successfully you must look ahead, and a good knowledge of your plants, and especially of the species you intend to exhibit, is a great help. It is also important to know what to expect from the judges, and how to judge them.

One of the most difficult problems is to know where to buy flowers at their peak at the time of the show. This is a question which can only be answered by experience.

So make a notebook and keep a record of the dates of sowing, transplanting, first flower, and full bloom.

If this is done for a few years it will be possible to estimate fairly exactly the time to sow seeds for a different flower, which is worth making a note of.

To obtain first-class blooms it is essential to use the best soil.

To enter a class for an amateur competition, there should be at least three entries, and it is better to have reasonable sets of flowers than a large number. The same applies to permanent exhibits.

FRIENDLY COUNSEL

Most flowers respond well to fertilizer, but certain varieties should be without it; compost should be applied to the soil, and a suitable amount of lime, and a good fertilizer, is best. It is better to add lime and often in the course of a year.

BRITAIN JOINS SPACE RACE

Plans to put ten 'moons' into orbit

BRITAIN has decided to join the space race with Russia, France and United States and may put the first man-made satellite into orbit using the Black Knight and Blue Streak rockets to launch it.

The news was given by the Prime Minister, Macmillan, in the House of Commons. He said work had already started on the adaptation for space research of British military missiles.

The Premier said Britain was to send a team of experts to Washington to discuss plans for the development of space research. A programme for the design and construction of instruments to be carried in the satellites had been approved and work was to begin at once.

The design should be put in hand for the first satellite of the Black Knight and Blue Streak rocket to be ready to put us in a position, should we decide to do so, to make an all-theatre effort," he said.

AMERICAN OFFER

Mr. Macmillan and his colleagues were being opened with Commonwealth countries (Next autumn, Commonwealth countries will meet in London for a conference on space research.)

He said he could not give any figures on the cost of launching the satellite. What they were doing now was to lay the foundation but modest sums, more in hundreds of thousands of pounds, were available for design of the instruments and to make the necessary designs for modification of the military rockets should Britain decide to do so.

At a Press conference after this Press Conference it was announced that the United States had already offered to put a British satellite into orbit.

He said: "I have not yet decided whether to accept this offer or go ahead alone to make the satellite an all-British venture."

Lord Hallifax, who is the Vice-Chairman of the Council, Lord Hallifax, would not say which Commonwealth countries were considered as potential partners.

He said: "We are extremely helpful to Britain and Britain was thinking of asking the United States to help in making a moon probe."

Sir Edward Heath said: "It would be possible to make a satellite which would be able to travel at a speed of 15 miles per second."
