Paper to discuss the issue. He felt that if that course of action had been followed, the House would have lost a day on its programme to discuss the Budget.

The matter, he said, involved the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Home Affairs. They could decide who was to deliver a statement.

Mr. Speaker told the House that it would help if the Government made a statement, perhaps today, to clear the air.

He did not agree with a submission by Mr. M. Wanjigi, an Assistant Minister for Agriculture, that the matter was *sub judice*.

Earlier, during Question Time, Mr. J. K. Gatuguta (Kikuyu) asked whether money spent on engineering students was worthwhile as, he said, the students were becoming "hooligans".

Mr. Wanjigi contended that it was only those doing political science who found time to strike. Money spent on engineering and science students was well spent.
