

'UNIVERSITY TO REOPEN IN JANUARY

THE UNIVERSITY of Nairobi will reopen on January 6, it was announced yesterday.

The announcement followed a meeting of the University Council.

A statement by the University Registrar, Mr. S. W. Karanja said: "The Council decided that the University should reopen on Monday, January 6, 1975.

"In preparation for the reopening on that date the Senate of the University is scheduled to meet on November 8, while the Council will meet further on November 28."

Mr. Karanja said questions relating to the reopening of the university and the terms and conditions "for which the university should be reopened were discussed" at yesterday's meeting.

But he did not elaborate on the terms and efforts by the NATION to contact members of the Council were unsuccessful.

Nairobi University and Kenyatta University College were closed on August 14, when defiant students refused to obey an order of the Council to return to lectures after a 10-day strike.

The Council then declared that it would support disciplinary action taken against students in breach of the colleges' regulations.
