The SAFIC Team led by Prof. Dorothy McCormick, and including Dr. Paul Kamau, Dr. Radha Upadhyaya, Mr. Peter K'Ochupe and Mr. Herbert Wamalwa attended a research workshop in Arusha - Tanzania, hosted by the Tanzania SAFIC Team. This was an annual event to enable the entire SAFIC Team to meet, discuss their research collaboration, and present their findings to one another. The first such workshop was held in Nairobi at the start of the project in February 2012. Subsequent workshops have been in Lusaka Zambia (2013) and Copenhagen, Denmark (2014).
