### How can you tell?

- ✓ You cannot always tell if an animal has rabies
- ✓ Not all animals with rabies look sick or act strange
- ❖ If you are **BITTEN** or if an **ANIMAL'S SALIVA** contacts your broken skin, eyes or mouth, immediately wash areas with soap and water and seek medical attention
