

To help support the University of Nairobi's world-class research environment, the **School of Journalism and Mass Communication** invites applications from outstanding candidates for a PhD scholarship. The successful candidate(s) will be expected to study **Agricultural Communication** and will be offered a grant during the three-year full time study starting in January 2016. The candidate must satisfy the School's requirement for PhD registration which includes submission of a comprehensive proposal by August 2015. Details of the award will be discussed with the successful candidate. Annual continuation of scholarship will depend on satisfactory academic performance.

Eligible students must ensure their applications contain ALL of the following:

- A motivation letter indicating the reasons for seeking to do the PhD.
- Written sample of no more than 2,000 words which demonstrates the applicant's skills as a researcher and/or shows skills in organising and presenting research findings.
- Copies of official academic certificates.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV).
