

The department of surgery organised a one day objective structured clinical examination (OSCE) workshop on the 5<sup>th</sup> March. Attendees included the departments of surgery, orthopaedics and anaesthesia.

Workshops aim was to remind staff of recent developments in various evaluation methods with special emphasis on the OSCE examination method. OSCE is becoming a popular examination method in the clinical areas due to its objectivity and popularity with students

The workshop was well attended, highly interactive and staff found the session very useful. The overwhelming resolution was that the department should follow our sister departments of medicine and paediatrics in giving OSCE examinations to undergraduates. Previously this had been thought as not possible due to the large numbers but the workshop indicated that it is possible.
