

Ebola A Global Health Threat, Ongoing and Planned Trials' Prof. Eleanor Fish, University of Toronto

Prof Eleanor Fish, a researcher and expert immuno-molecular biologist from the University of Toronto, Canada, gave a scholarly state of the art lecture on Ebola on which was organized by the Department of Human Pathology. In her lecture, Prof. Fish described the current Ebola epidemic in West Africa and the measures being taken to control the epidemic so far including vaccine development. She also described the rationale of her own team's planned trial with interferon. The lecture was attended by members of staff and postgraduate students from the CHS. The Dean School of Medicine Prof. Fred Were welcomed Prof. Eleanor and encouraged her research unit to collaborate with the School. The Department of Human Pathology is exploring research and teaching collaboration with Prof. Fish in the area of molecular immunopathology
