

Professor T. Madiba visits department

Professor T.E. Madiba was the 2014 Rahima Dawood Travelling Fellow of the College of Surgeons of East, Central and Southern Africa (COSECSA) and the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (RCSE). The Travelling Fellow was one of the very first projects of the Rahima Dawood foundation and started in 1990. The travelling Fellow is an eminent surgeon nominated on a rotational basis by COSECSA and the RCSEd to travel throughout the region delivering surgical lectures on a selected topic. The visit usually stretches over a three week period and the surgical topic is usually selected by COSECSA focusing on topics of local interest.

Professor Madiba is Professor and Head of the Department of Surgery at the University of KwaZulu - Natal in Durban, South Africa. He is also the Head of the Colorectal Unit in Durban and is an expert on diseases of the colon, rectum and anus. His main research interests are Sigmoid Volvulus and Colorectal Cancer.

Prof Madibe gave lectures in Burundi and Malawi before coming to Kenya. He visited UoN CHS on Tues 11 November, 2014 and presented his lecture on recent developments in colorectal surgery and his topic focused on Sigmoid Volvulus and Colorectal Cancer.

He presented his final oration in Dar Es Salaam at the December Annual AGM and Scientific conference for COSECSA
