It will be an analytical cross-sectional study aimed at determining the prevalence and clinical presentation of endometriosis among patients undergoing elective gynaecologic laparoscopy in Kenyatta National Hospital, Nairobi Hospital, Nazareth Hospital and International Center for Minimally Invasive Surgery (ICMAS). On laparoscopic suspicion of endometriosis, biopsy specimens will be taken for histopathological confirmation at the Institute of Primate Research (IPR).
