The Anatomic Pathology Unit now has improved histology capacity for clinical and autopsy pathology. Services offered include routine histology and cytology including special stains and immunohistochemistry. The unit has capacity for Tissue Micro-Array construction and analysis. Developments of molecular pathology capacity including In-Situ hybridization are at an advanced stage. Telepathology using static photomicrography is available and useful in teaching and consultation.
