

CAE's new Van Commissioned by Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Administration and Finance

It was pomp and colour at the College of Architecture and Engineering when the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Administration and Finance, Prof. Bernard N. K. Njoroge commissioned a van at the college today , Wednesday, June, 10, 2015.
