The Department of Plant Science and Crop Protection has today, the 19th September 2013 launched the <u>Master of Science in Agronomy</u> Open Distance Learning Programme (ODL). This is a major milestone for the department and the Faculty of Agriculture. Master of Science in Agronomy ODL mode is the fourth post graduate programme the department has rolled out in a span of four years.

This mode of delivery was pioneered by <u>Master of Science in Crop Protection</u> which has so far attracted more than fifty students. <u>Master of Science Horticulture</u>, Agricultural Resource Management and now Agronomy are offered in both fulltime and ODL modes. Among other advantages to this mode of deliver is its flexibility.
