Call for Innovation Essays, Case Studies and Papers

INNOVATION ESSAYS

These are articles founded on sound theory and have policy implications. They should be written in general readership language. Innovation essays should be a maximum of 4 pages for all text, including an abstract of 150 words, references, appendices, and figures. Template guideline follows the IEEE format

INNOVATION CASES STUDIES

These are case studies of innovation successes, challenges, good practice and learning from the business world (for-profit and not-for-profit organizations). They are written with structured headings for a general innovation audience. An innovation case study should be a maximum of 10 pages for all text, including an abstract of 250 words, appendices, figures, and references. Template guideline follows the IEEE format

ACADEMIC PAPERS

These are accomplished, substantial and complete academic research results of a theoretical, conceptual or empirical nature. An academic paper should be a maximum of 7 pages for all text, including an abstract of 200 words, appendices, figures, and references. Template guideline follows the IEEE format
