Mr. Michael Mangala and Mr. Anzelmus Matini attended the two-day meeting. Mr. Mangala is the Coordinator of Project KEN/1/004, "Establishing an NDT Laboratory at the Institute of Nuclear Science and Technology, University of Nairobi for Training, Research and Service Provision in the field of NDT Applications". He also made a presentation of the project activities to date. Mr. Matini is the Coordinator of Project RAF/0/041, "Sharing Best Practices in Preventive Maintenance of Nuclear Equipment". The meeting was called by Kenya's International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Liaison Officer Hon Ochilo Ayacko, the Executive Chairman/CEO of Kenya Nuclear Electricity Board (KNEB). The meeting was called to: 1. review on-going Technical Cooperation (TC) Programme, discuss issues related to TC Country programme for 2014/2015 and review Country Programme Framework (CPF) There was also a meeting with the IAEA Programme Management Officer for Kenya Ms. Thabisile Moleah. During the meeting, the following thematic areas were discussed for the CPF: i) Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries Development ii) Human Health iii) Water Resources Management iv) Energy Development v) Industrial Applications. These five sectors were identified as priority areas for IAEA support and Messrs Mangala and Matini were part of the team to review the earlier CPF.
