Submission guidelines: Proposals which should be limited to five pages single-spaced (including references and appendices) should identify the research problems, questions, methods, brief review of the literature, timetable and budget. Author(s) should also enclose their CVs which should not exceed two pages. Proposals should demonstrate originality. Please email your proposals to hodaccounting@mubs.ac.ug. The deadline for submission of proposals is 31st May, 2013.
