

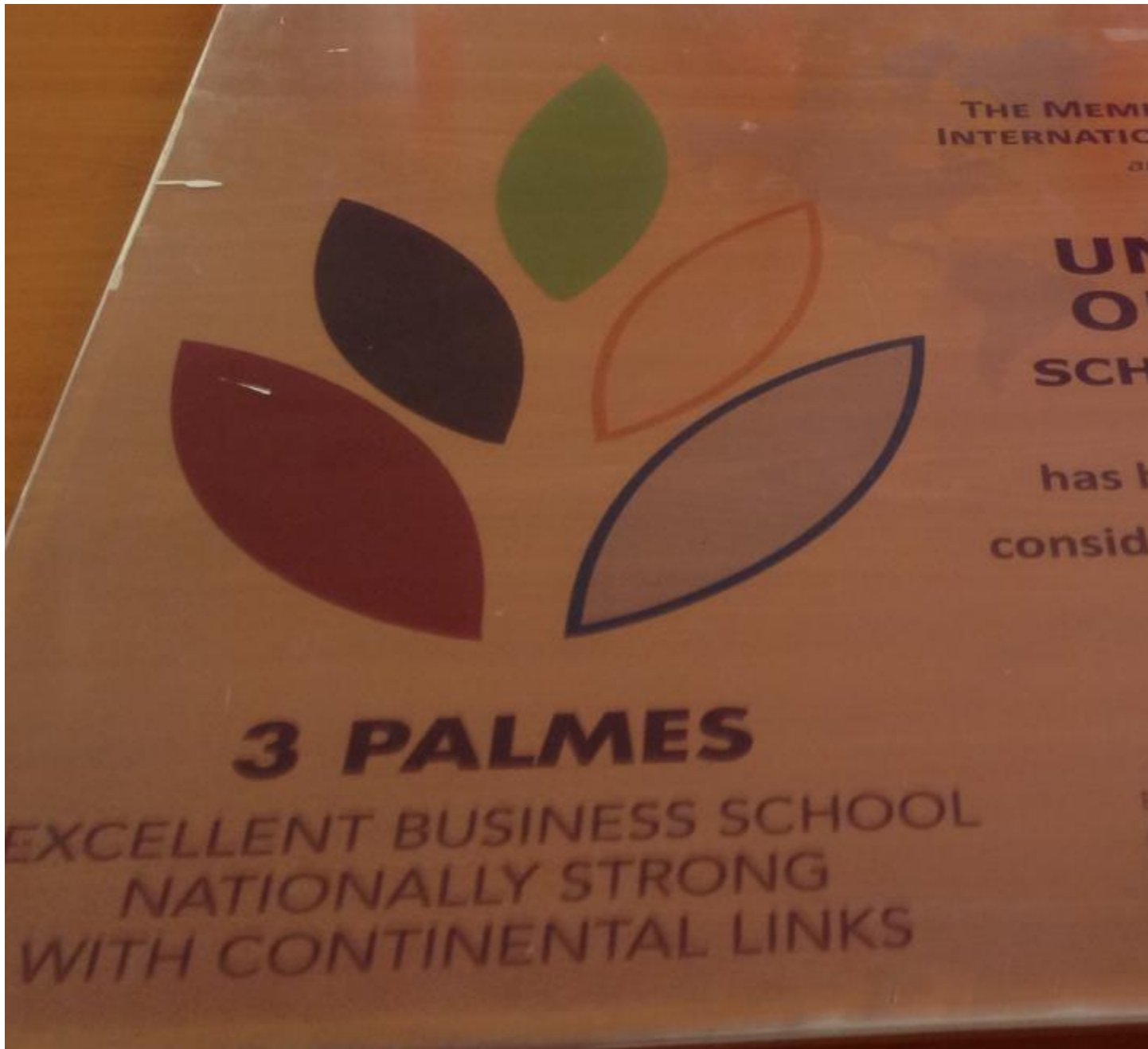
# **SCHOOL OF BUSINESS RANKED BEST IN KENYA, EAST AND CENTRAL AFRICA**
