Minimum admission requirements:

KCSE (Mean C+) or A Level (2 Principal passes) or its equivalent; or EACE or KCE Division III or, KCSE with a C (plain) plus a Diploma from a recognized institution or equivalent; or KCSE with a C- (minus) plus a Certificate and a Diploma or equivalent.

Application Procedure:

Application forms can be obtained from the Admissions Office Reception Room 16, located at the Main Campus of the University, Administration block, first floor upon payment of a non-refundable application fee of Kshs 3,000. (Note: Non-Kenyans pay 25% more on all charges). The application fee may be paid by Direct Deposit into the UNES/UON Account, Barclays Bank, Westlands Branch, A/C No. 03-073-1023948. CASH AND POSTAL ORDERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. The application forms are also obtained from Kisumu at MEGA CITY building and Mombasa Campus at UNI-PLAZA.
