About Course

This curriculum has been developed for the purpose of ensuring uniformity, consistence and standardization of the scope and content of the first aid training at workplaces.

Trainees are taught how to handle issues to do with:

- 1. Bleeding emergencies and Treatment of minor injuries likeNose bleeding,Arterial bleeding,Bleeding from injured veinsand Internal bleeding
- 2. Management of amputated Fingers, Hand, Arm, Toes, Foot and Leg
- 3. Management of fractures e.gNeck and skull fracture, Jaw fracture, Limbs fractures, Rib fractures and Vertebral column fractures
- 4. Eye Injuries pertaining Foreign object in the eye, Perforation of the eye, Cut on the eye, Allergies from contact with chemicals, Contact with corrosive chemicals, Injuries due to radiation, Heat burn and Injury from a blow
- 5. Ear Injuries
- 6. Burns and Scalds including Chemical burns from corrosive chemicals, Direct burns from flame, Burns from contact with hot objects, Scalds from hot liquids and Electrical burns
- 7. Unconsciousness (Causes and treatment)
- 8. Cardio -Pulmonary Resuscitation
- 9. Gassing emergencies

- 10. First Aid to people with special problems like Asthmatic persons, Epileptic persons, Diabetic person, Hypertensive stroke and Obstetrical emergencies
- 11. Ingestion of corrosive and toxic substances
- 12. Lifting and carrying casualties
- 13. Precautions to be taken against contracting HIV/AIDS while giving First Aid
- 14. Requirements under the First Aid Rules –LN 160/1977
- 15. Shock (Causes and treatment)
- 16. Animal and insect bites
- 17. Emergency preparedness and response

After the end of this course, Examination and testing both written and orals/practicals are given.
