For the first time, Deputy Vice-Chancellors and the college Principals sign performance contracts. This took place on September 14, 2015 at the Council Chambers.

The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Peter Mbithi signed the contracts with them while Dr. Idle Farah, Chairman of Council witnessed.

Speaking during the signing ceremony, Dr. Idle Farah noted that the Performance Contract has been crafted based on the *Mwongozo* code of conduct, the University Strategic Plan, the Budget, the Medium Plan II and the Kenya Vision 2030, as stipulated in the 12th cycle Performance Contract guidelines.

Service delivery, corruption eradication, automation of university operations, resolution of public complains and development of infrastructure to support teaching, learning, research and consultancy are Key in the Performance Contract.

Following the recent security incidences in the country, comprehensive security measures have been put in place and are now part of the performance contract.

The management will be expected to deliver on the targets and surpass them as the university strives towards achieving its mandate of being the centre of scholarly excellence. Later on the Vice-Chancellor will sign Performance Contracts with Central departmental heads, who will then cascade it to other staff in the lower cadre.
