On September 14, 2015, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Peter M. F. Mbithi signed performance contracts with four Deputy Vice-Chancellors and College Principals in the council chamber. The management has included comprehensive security measures in the performance contract (PC) following recent security incidences in the country.

Among crucial aspects that the performance contract is meant to measure include: **service delivery, corruption eradication, automation** of university operations, resolution of **public complaints** and development of **infrastructure** to support teaching, learning, research and consultancy at the University of Nairobi.

Dr. Idle Farah, Chairman of Council who witnessed the performance signing, noted that PC is important in results measurement.

The PC has been crafted based on the *Mwongozo* code of conduct, the University Strategic Plan, the Budget, the Medium Plan II and the Kenya Vision 2030.

The management will be expected to deliver and even surpass the targets as the University strives towards achieving its mandate of being the centre of scholarly excellence. The Vice-Chancellor is expected to sign Performance Contracts with Central departmental heads .
