

College holds an Academic Board Meeting

College Academic Board Directors and academic staff met to look into student's academic performance where they reported the students' pass, fail, repeat list and students' recommendations to proceed to the next level of study.

Student mentorship was also highlighted during the meeting. A call of appeal has been made to all mentors in the College to give their names so that they can join the team of trainer of trainers in the **Student Mentorship Program**. This follows an approval by the University Senate to set up the Centre for Pedagogy and Andragogy as the new centre for student mentorship.

Also discussed was the **review of curriculum** of the degree programs offered at the College of Biological and Physical Sciences. Heads of units are to provide a report on their respective review of courses. This reinforces [University of Nairobi's](#) mandate to streamline courses to the needs of the industry and to enhance innovation, invention and entrepreneurship skills in its curriculum.
