On December 4, 2015, the University of Nairobi held its 54th graduation congregation at the Graduation Square Grounds. During this graduation ceremony **8,861 graduands** were conferred with PhDs, Degrees and awarded Post Graduate Diplomas and Diplomas. The event was preceded over by the Chancellor, Dr. Rattansi.

The School of Continuing and Distance Education produced 994 Graduands in the December graduation; with 523 being male and 471 being female.
