- 4 When the Chancellor takes his stand on the dais the National Anthem will be played. When the Chancellor has taken his seat all will sit.
- 5 The Vice-Chancellor will constitute the Assembly a Congregation of the University of Nairobi.
- 6 The Chairman will deliver a speech of welcome.
- 7 The Vice-Chancellor will address the Congregation.
- 8 The Registrar will then call upon the Deans of the Faculties to present their candidates for the award of diplomas and conferment of degrees of the University of Nairobi.

9 The Chancellor, His Excellency, the Hon. Mzee Jomo Kenyatta, C.G.H., M.P., Hon. LLD (Nairobi) (East Africa) (Manchester) and (Haile Selassie I) will deliver his address to the Congregation.
